TODAY'S INTRODUCTION

-Welcome to United Israel World Union, this is our Sabbath morning scripture study coming to you live from the United Israel Center in Saint Francisville, Louisiana. Many of you are in your own place today, alone, Shabbat Shalom and thank you for joining us this morning. We need one another to help us go through what the world is going through today. I pray that all of you and the ones that you care for remain healthy today and throughout the coronavirus.

-We are currently beginning a new teaching series called, “Prophet” where I want to talk about the subject, the people, and the message of that mysterious group of men and women that are biblically referred to as the Prophet. We just completed a 12-part series called “Torah”. The primary purpose of that study was to show and teach a method whereby you can determine within the first five books of the bible, Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy, the hand of Moses. What is it that Moses wrote? This series was important because it gives us the essential tools to recognize apart from tradition and our beliefs, the voice of Moses in the five books. If we were able to determine the things that Moses said, then might we also be able to determine that which YHVH has said? Please join us as we begin our teaching series called, “Prophet”.

TEACHING NOTES

-Today we are in our first class in our series on the Prophet and today's class is called “Prophet – Hath God Said? – Class One”. As we learned in our previous study, if we can determine the hand of Moses within the five books, and recognize his voice within those writings then how much more so within this sacred body of literature, might we be able to identify the voice of God? What we are looking for now within the five books and prophets and the writings is for the words of God. This is important for the people of the

book. Scripture contains poetry, prose, narratives, history, and psalms and within that literature is preserved the word of God.

-For the past 12 weeks by carefully studying these five books we've identified the clues for evidence of the Scroll of Moses because we trust what's written. It's important for the bible to speak on the bible's behalf and that we trust the words of scripture above the opinions of people. We are looking for, what does the bible say? We are going to continue along this same method by trusting the words of the bible and the way it was written. We paid close attention to styles, grammar, first person and third person narratives and we were able to identify a book within a book. If we were able to determine the things that Moses said, then might we also be able to determine that which the creator said, what YHVH has said?

-I titled last week's class, "The Secret of the Torah". In that class I showed that there were two great Torah teachers. Rabbi Abraham Ibn Ezra and a student of his writings named Joseph Bonfils. The secret of the Torah they noticed is that you could see the hands of authors other than Moses. Ultimately, they said this is something that should not be shared with the general population. It's important for people of the book / scripture to understand and be able to identify different speakers. Ultimately, they realized that Moses didn't say or write everything in Genesis 1:1 through Deuteronomy 34:12. To balance this they noted they have traditional views and the words of the prophets. What Joseph Bonfils said is a perfect entry into today's class, "Whether Moses or one of the other prophets wrote these other words, it matters not." According to Joseph Bonfils, all their words were true.

-From the opening words of the bible, we are introduced to the greatest question of all time in the biblical text. The serpent said to the woman, "What hath God said?". The answer to this question is the foundation of our new informative study called, Prophet. It becomes necessary for people of faith to know what God has said, and to be able to distinguish his words from the words of others, because we ought to place the words of God higher and more important than the words of anyone else. We are looking to discern the words of God.

-When this question was asked from the serpent to the woman, the woman made a mistake. This is a mistake that we should all avoid. "What hath God said?" When she responded, she added to the words of God. She said that God said, things that God did not say. Some say by doing so they created a fence around the command that was given to them.

-Gen 2: 15 YHVH God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it. 16 And YHVH God commanded the man, saying, "You may surely eat of every tree of the garden, 17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

-We have the command given by YHVH Elohim to the man. Let's get beyond who did what and focus on the problem, the sin / crime itself. We have a command that they may eat of all the fruit of the trees of the garden except for the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Here the first commandment in scripture is associated with dietary rules and they are forbidden to eat from one simple tree. It comes with a consequence, the day that you eat thereof, dying you shall surely die.

-Gen 3: 1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that YHVH Elohim had made. He said to the woman, "Did God actually say, 'You shall not eat of any

tree in the garden'?" 2 And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden, 3 but God said, 'You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the midst of the garden, neither shall you touch it, lest you die.'"

-We just read that God said, you shall freely eat from all the trees but from the one in the midst of the garden, lest you die. She said, God has said, you shall not eat from it, but she adds, "neither shall you touch it". God didn't say they couldn't touch it. Technically they could touch it or lick it, but they just couldn't eat it. People tend to create a boundary around the forbidden, so they don't encroach on it. We put things in place to protect ourselves from sin. God said, don't eat it and they said, we won't even touch it. It's ok to do that, however the problem is when you say, God said that.

-In the Talmud, Jewish literature, in Sanhedrin 29a, one of the Rabbis was looking at this and said, he who adds subtracts. If you add to the words of God, in a sense you're taking away from it, changing it, and adulterating the very word of God. You've placed your words on the level with the words of God. The purpose of this class is to teach us to distinguish between that which God has said that which another has said. We should be on the lookout for words that people said that God said that he didn't say. The bible has this, and this is one of the reasons for this study. I want to show you clear indications as we study, how to identify that which YHVH has spoken and when others are quoting that which YHVH has spoken. I also want to demonstrate and caution you when someone said that YHVH said something that he clearly did not say or that we don't have a record of as we preparing to go on a journey of the prophets.

-Pro 30: 5 Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him. 6 Do not add to his words, lest he rebuke you and you be found a liar.

-Every word of God "proves" true. In Hebrew, the word "proves" has to do with refining, taking something that is mixed with pure and impure elements and placing it in the fire where the bad is burned off and what's left is pure. Purified, trusted, proven and refined. The words of God are refined truth after everything else / additions, things that others have said God said and didn't, are stripped and burned away. We only want things that are trusted, trustworthy, proven, and are true. We want to boil things away and look clearly at the pure words of God. The words of God are proven as precious metal is purified and refined by the fire.

-Psa 12: 6 The words of YHVH are pure words, like silver refined in a furnace on the ground, purified seven times.

-Psa 18: 30 This God--his way is perfect; the word of YHVH proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him. (This is also tied to 2Samuel 22)

-It's significant that being purified and refined is used to describe the word of God. That which is most precious must be pulled from the common / profane. Jeremiah 15 talks about this. We're looking at something that is not completely pure but has the purest of elements within it. Through smelting and the heat of the fire that which is pure and the most valuable is brought out.

-Psa 119: 140 Your promise (word) is well tried, and your servant loves it.

-Over time the word of God has been incorporated into the words of others. The history, poetry, prose, narration, the words of God are part of that. This study is intended to figuratively bring up the heat and show forth / recognize that which is the words of YHVH and most important. In Proverbs 30: 6 "Do not add to his words, lest he rebuke you and you be found a liar." The decision in the garden was to take the command

seriously and to add to the words of that command. Don't eat, they said not even to touch. They added to the words of God because she said that he said. Because she said, YHVH said, she lied.

-Deu 4: 1 "And now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the rules that I am teaching you, and do them, that you may live, and go in and take possession of the land that YHVH, the God of your fathers, is giving you. 2 You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of YHVH your God that I command you.

-Moses makes it clear as the children prepare to go into the land that he's commanding them, commandments that YHVH told him to command them and he says, don't add to it or take away from it, because the commands that he gives to them come from the mouth of YHVH. That which Moses writes in the Moses Scroll is that which God had commanded him to command the children of Israel.

-Exo 24: 3 Moses came and told the people all the words of YHVH and all the rules. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words that YHVH has spoken we will do." 4 And Moses wrote down all the words of YHVH. He rose early in the morning and built an altar at the foot of the mountain, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel.

-Exo 24: 7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it in the hearing of the people. And they said, "All that YHVH has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient."

-Moses recorded the words of YHVH and in Exodus 24 the people agreed to keep those words. What does it mean to keep? In Deuteronomy 4:1-2 he says don't add to or take away from so that you might keep the commandments. The Hebrew word for keep means to guard. To guard the word of God means to not let others add to it or take away from it. When you add to it you didn't guard the word of God and you set yourself up for the fall and to be found a liar.

-Deu 12: 32 "Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it or take from it.

-At the beginning of scripture and at the beginning of our new series we receive a warning, what has God said? In our study, by determining what God has said, we will also be identifying things that God did not say from the same book and we've been warned with consequences. The violation of God's command brings death. We want to use our abilities and make a distinction.

-Growing up in a traditional religious home and loving the bible, I called the bible the word of God. This is the word of God, but I want to change that. This book contains within it's covers, the words of the living God. Not every word in this book is the word of God. It is the word of God we should be interested in identifying because they should be held on a higher level than the words of others. How are we to know / identify which words are the words of God and which ones aren't? Over the next several weeks we will look at clear indications that show us, beyond a doubt, these are the words that God spoke, and these are not.

-Deu 4: 10 how on the day that you stood before YHVH your God at Horeb, YHVH said to me, 'Gather the people to me, that I may let them hear my words, so that they may learn to fear me all the days that they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children so.' 11 And you came near and stood at the foot of the mountain, while the mountain burned with fire to the heart of heaven, wrapped in darkness, cloud, and gloom.

12 Then YHVH spoke to you out of the midst of the fire. You heard the sound of words, but saw no form; there was only a voice. 13 And he declared to you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, that is, the Ten Commandments, and he wrote them on two tablets of stone. 14 And YHVH commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and rules, that you might do them in the land that you are going over to possess.

-YHVH tells Moses to gather the people to him so the people might hear my words. The purpose of this study is to determine within scripture, which are the words of YHVH?

-Deu 5: 1 And Moses summoned all Israel and said to them, "Hear, O Israel, the statutes and the rules that I speak in your hearing today, and you shall learn them and be careful to do them. 2 YHVH our God made a covenant with us in Horeb. 3 Not with our fathers did YHVH make this covenant, but with us, who are all of us here alive today. 4 YHVH spoke with you face to face at the mountain, out of the midst of the fire, 5 while I stood between YHVH and you at that time, to declare to you the word of YHVH. For you were afraid because of the fire, and you did not go up into the mountain.

-Deu 5: 22 "These words YHVH spoke to all your assembly at the mountain out of the midst of the fire, the cloud, and the thick darkness, with a loud voice; and he added no more. And he wrote them on two tablets of stone and gave them to me. 23 And as soon as you heard the voice out of the midst of the darkness, while the mountain was burning with fire, you came near to me, all the heads of your tribes, and your elders. 24 And you said, 'Behold, YHVH our God has shown us his glory and greatness, and we have heard his voice out of the midst of the fire. This day we have seen God speak with man, and man still live. 25 Now therefore why should we die? For this great fire will consume us. If we hear the voice of YHVH our God any more, we shall die. 26 For who is there of all flesh, that has heard the voice of the living God speaking out of the midst of fire as we have, and has still lived? 27 Go near and hear all that YHVH our God will say, and speak to us all that YHVH our God will speak to you, and we will hear and do it.' 28 "And YHVH heard your words, when you spoke to me. And YHVH said to me, 'I have heard the words of this people, which they have spoken to you. They are right in all that they have spoken. 29 Oh that they had such a heart as this always, to fear me and to keep all my commandments, that it might go well with them and with their descendants forever!

-The people were so terrified at the presence of God, the flames, the lightning and the ominous clouds, that the people went to Moses and said to him, you go hear what God says and you tells us, we don't want to witness this again. That began something totally different. YHVH tells Moses, that which they have spoken is good.

-Exo 20: 18 Now when all the people saw the thunder and the flashes of lightning and the sound of the trumpet and the mountain smoking, the people were afraid and trembled, and they stood far off 19 and said to Moses, "You speak to us, and we will listen; but do not let God speak to us, lest we die." 20 Moses said to the people, "Do not fear, for God has come to test you, that the fear of him may be before you, that you may not sin." 21 The people stood far off, while Moses drew near to the thick darkness where God was.

-Deu 18: 9 "When you come into the land that YHVH your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominable practices of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering, anyone who practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer 11 or a charmer or a medium or a necromancer or one who inquires of the dead, 12 for whoever does these

things is an abomination to YHVH. And because of these abominations YHVH your God is driving them out before you.

-These methods are against the word of YHVH. To go in and let someone to divine the word from another realm. This is not permitted.

-Deu 18: 13 You shall be blameless before YHVH your God, 14 for these nations, which you are about to dispossess, listen to fortune-tellers and to diviners. But as for you, YHVH your God has not allowed you to do this. 15 "YHVH your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers--it is to him you shall listen-- 16 just as you desired of YHVH your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, 'Let me not hear again the voice of YHVH my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.' 17 And YHVH said to me, 'They are right in what they have spoken. 18 I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. 19 And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him. 20 But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.' 21 And if you say in your heart, 'How may we know the word that YHVH has not spoken?'-- 22 when a prophet speaks in the name of YHVH, if the word does not come to pass or come true, that is a word that YHVH has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously. You need not be afraid of him.

-YHVH doesn't say that what soothsayers say doesn't work, he says that's not permitted and you are not allowed to do that. You will hear the words of YHVH through his prophet that YHVH will raise up from among your people and he says, I will put my words in his mouth. When the prophet speaks, you're hearing directly from YHVH because that's what they requested at Horeb. We must learn to identify that which comes from a true prophet. How are we going to know if someone is a prophet? They will speak the words of YHVH in the name of YHVH. If someone says a word, claiming it to be from me in my name, but it's not from me, it won't come true. They've spoken presumptuously and you don't have to be afraid of them. If they do this the consequences are dire.

-YHVH will raise up a prophet and to that one we are to listen. From your midst, from your brethren, like me because of what they requested. YHVH says he's going to put his words in the mouth of this one. This is key, the prophets are not speaking their own words. The words which the prophets speak when they are filled with the Spirit of God, when YHVH's words are in their mouth, they are not speaking their words, but the one that sent them. They are speaking the words of YHVH.

-Deu 12: 32 "Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it or take from it.

-Deu 13: 1 "If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, 2 and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, 'Let us go after other gods,' which you have not known, 'and let us serve them,' 3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams. For YHVH your God is testing you, to know whether you love YHVH your God with all your heart and with all your soul. 4 You shall walk after YHVH your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him. 5 But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has taught

rebellion against YHVH your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt and redeemed you out of the house of slavery, to make you leave the way in which YHVH your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.

-If someone performs a sign or a miracle in the name of another god besides YHVH, it's not acceptable. Be careful, what spirit do you feel moving there? Scripture says, despite the miracle / sign, if it's associated with the name of another god it's not right. The true prophet will have the words of YHVH in his mouth. The true prophet will speak what YHVH commands him to speak and it will encourage the listener to keep the ways of YHVH and not some other contrary message. Whom are they a prophet for? What words are coming out of that person's mouth?

-I'm looking to discern that which YHVH has spoken through a prophet that YHVH has raised up who will command the people to keep that which YHVH tells him to command the people to keep. These true prophets will speak in the name of YHVH and not in the name of another. When a prophet speaks in the name of YHVH, if that doesn't come to pass that which they speak it clearly wasn't a word that YHVH spoke.

-With all this criteria in place we can move forward over the next several weeks and determine prophet and thereby distinguish the words of YHVH because the prophet when speaking the words of YHVH, is not speaking their own words but the words of the one who sent them. They will announce it and say certain things that will allow us to know and identify them as a prophet of YHVH. They could be a prophet of another. I'm interested in are they a prophet of YHVH?

-Since Sinai when YHVH spoke to his people through an audible voice out of the midst of the fire on the day of assembly and so startled the nation, there's not been another event like it.

-Deu 4: 32 "For ask now of the days that are past, which were before you, since the day that God created man on the earth, and ask from one end of heaven to the other, whether such a great thing as this has ever happened or was ever heard of. 33 Did any people ever hear the voice of a god speaking out of the midst of the fire, as you have heard, and still live? 34 Or has any god ever attempted to go and take a nation for himself from the midst of another nation, by trials, by signs, by wonders, and by war, by a mighty hand and an outstretched arm, and by great deeds of terror, all of which YHVH your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes? 35 To you it was shown, that you might know that YHVH is God; there is no other besides him. 36 Out of heaven he let you hear his voice, that he might discipline you. And on earth he let you see his great fire, and you heard his words out of the midst of the fire. 37 And because he loved your fathers and chose their offspring after them and brought you out of Egypt with his own presence, by his great power, 38 driving out before you nations greater and mightier than you, to bring you in, to give you their land for an inheritance, as it is this day, 39 know therefore today, and lay it to your heart, that YHVH is God in heaven above and on the earth beneath; there is no other. 40 Therefore you shall keep his statutes and his commandments, which I command you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days in the land that YHVH your God is giving you for all time."

-The reason is that the people were so startled that they requested to do things differently that indeed they wanted to know God's will and do what God said to do and they wanted

Moses to go and God said that was a good request. And that throughout time he would raise up his prophets.

-Amo 3: 7 "For Adonai YHVH does nothing without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets.

-God does nothing unless he reveals his secrets unto the servants the prophets and they speak those words. By studying the words of the prophets, you will learn to discern the word which YHVH has spoken. You will be able to answer with authority the question, what hath God said? The bible contains the words of God, but it contains other words as well. We must be able to discern between the words which YHVH spoke and the words he didn't speak. When the prophets speak YHVH's words they tell us directly on many occasions. But there are other methods based on a careful study of scripture we can determine that which YHVH has said.

-Thus, we begin a study into the words of the prophets. The style and manner of speech is consistent but it's consistently mysterious as well. Few have understood the true meaning of the words of the prophets because they fail to fully grasp the one who spoke through them. Many people jump in and read the prophets and begin to try to interpret the words of the prophets and thus the words of YHVH, but they are not prepared to do so. Many people look at the words in a prophetic book and don't understanding the historical context and that it's already done. Or they're looking at something that's not yet come to pass, and they don't understand the words and are trying to identify who is the servant of the LORD in Isaiah's writings. They don't know what the Hebrew says behind the English and they make crucial mistakes. A close and careful study of the words, in connection with the words, and on the basis of the words of the scriptures will give us the tools necessary to answer the question posed in the garden. What has God said?

-This series coming in the following weeks to quote the late Rabbi Abraham Heschel is about some of the most disturbing people who have ever lived. The men whose inspiration brought the bible into being. The men whose images are refuge in distress and whose voice sustain our faith. The significance of Israel's prophet lies not only in what they said, but also in what they were. What truly is a prophet? Join us next Saturday morning at 10:30am Central Time as we begin to look at, truly what is a prophet?
